the current expiration date of July 4, 2014, to continue to be available until expended. The total of \$3.4M is appropriated for certain flood mitigation projects listed under Section 2 of the same law from the un-appropriated fund balance of the Guam Territorial Highway Fund to Department of Public Works. It is noted that Section 3 of P.L. 32-053 provides that any excess funds shall be used by the Director of DPW to fulfill additional work as listed in Section 2, but without expressing any set timeline for use of the excess funds. The Government's AS400 financial system currently reflects Expenditures of \$22,140, Outstanding Encumbrances of \$1,928,160 and Funds Available of \$1,449,700. The funds appropriated for the mayors' flood mitigation projects will go toward the purchase and/or rental of heavy equipment and labor/overtime costs for project monitoring, clearance of debris, transfer of debris to a designated staring

AN ACT TO EXTEND THE EXPENDITURE TIMELINE FOR THE APPROPRIATION FROM THE GUAM TERRITORIAL HIGHWAY **FUND** PURSUANT TO 32-053. P.L. TOE DESIGNATE AND **CERTAIN** CAPITAI PRIORITIZE IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR FLOOD MITIGATION AND OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Finding and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that the Department of Public Works requires additional time to complete the ongoing *request for proposal*, contract negotiations, and project award process for the capital improvement projects for flood mitigation, as authorized and funded pursuant to P.L. 32-53. It is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to extend the expenditure timeline until funding is expended.

8 Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 32-053 is hereby AMENDED, to
9 read:

10 "Section 3. Unused Appropriation. Funds <u>may be not</u> expended pursuant 11 to the provisions of this Act within one year following the date of enactment, <u>and</u> 12 shall <u>continue to no longer</u> be available for its stated purpose <u>until expended</u>. Any 13 excess funds *shall* be used by the Director of DPW to fulfill additional work listed 14 in Section 2 of this Act."

15 Section 3. Effective Date. This Act shall become immediately effective
 16 upon enactment.
