The Bureau requests that Bill No. 342-32 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 342-32(COR) is an Act to rezone Lot No. 22 New, Block No. 9, in the municipality of Dededo, from a Single-Family Dwelling Zone (R-1) to a Commercial Zone (C).

Per the Department of Revenue & Taxation, the land and building tax rates remain the same regardless of the change to any property's zoning. Per the Department of Land Management, zone changes done through legislation are not charged any fees in regards to zone change amendments or certification of zoning fees. AN ACT TO REZONE LOT NO. 22, BLOCK 9 IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DEDEDO FROM RESIDENTIAL (R-1) TO COMMERCIAL (C).

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the following lot as described below is hereby rezoned from Residential (R-1) to Commercial (C):

Lot No. 22, Block 9, in the municipality of Dededo, containing an area of 1,12761± square meters, referenced to map filed under Drawing No. E4-55-343, Instrument No. 34224.

Section 2. Effective Date. This provision contained herein shall take effect immediately upon enactment of this Act.

Section 3. Severability. *If* any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application and to this end the provisions of this Act is severable.
