Comments:

In its current form, the subject Bill intends to clarify that Ordot-Chalan Pago is eligible to receive host community premiums during the post-closure period and to give the Municipal Planning Councils of Ordot-Chalan Pago and Inarajan the governing authority over such premiums / funds. It is projected that each municipality may receive approximately \$4.5M (\$150K per year for 30 years) as this is both the recommended time frame for post-closure monitoring and maintenance of the Ordot dump as well as the life expectancy of the new Layon landfill in Inarajan. Of particular concern are Sections 3 and 4 of the Bill. Section 3 seeks to exempt the Host Community Fund from Ch.4 of 5 GCA by excluding the Fund from provisions of the Government of Guam's annual executive budget law. Section 4 delegates procurement of supplies & services to the Chief Procurement Officers of respective Host Community municipalities rather than through the General Services Agency.
