Comments:

1/ This proposed legislation is aimed at transferring the title to/jurisdiction over the parcel of real property in the municipalities of Barrigada and Dededo encompassing Lot No. 1 NEW-1, Block No. 2, Tract 1427 containing an area of about 61,449 square feet or about 5,709 square meters from the Guam International Airport Authority (GIAA) to the Chamorro Land Trust Commission (CLTC). There is currently a revenue generating source on the said parcel of property in the form of lease payments for rental expenses of a fuel service station. The transfer of said property and revenue generated through the lease will support mandates under the CLTC to include, but not limited to: the Chamorro Home Loan Fund; Chamorro Loan Guarantee Fund. GIAA had previously expressed the illegality of a similar proposal in previous legislations, specifically Bill No. 14-31. However, if the proposed legislation is passed and the title to/jurisdiction over said property is transferred to the CLTC, the Bureau estimates that \$217,341.63 of yearly revenues will be received by the CLTC in the form of lease payments from the existing fuel service station.

Bueñas Yan Hafa Adai: The Department has reviewed Bill 55-32 (COR) – An Act Relative to Transfer of the Title of Ownership of Lot No. 1NEW-1, Block No. 2, Tract 1427 in the Municipality of Barrigada and Dededo to the Chamorro Land Trust Commission. We provide the following causes for our support of its intent:

- The Department agrees with the findings of the legislative proposal where the transfer of Lot 1NEW-1 to the Guarn International Airport Authority is not in line with the mandates of the autonomous agency. Pursuant to Title 12, Division1, Chapter 1, Article 1, the purpose for the Airport's authority and existence is to acquire, construct, reconstruct, purchase, extend, improve, better, operate and maintain airports and related facilities for civil aviation purposes on Guam. A gas station services domestic and commercial wheeled-vehicles and does not support any civil aviation process or program.
- 2. The transfer of said property under the guise of the CLTC will serve as appropriate source as revenue-generating program to support mandates under the CLTC to include, but not limited to: the Chamorro Home Loan Fund; Chamorro Home Development Fund; Chamorro Educational Fund; Chamorro Commercial Loan Fund; and the Chamorro Loan Guarantee Fund. In this respect, the transfer of said property will have a positive fiscal impact to ultimately support the benefactors of the Chamorro Land Trust Commission.





AN ACT RELATIVE TO TRANSFER OF THE TITLE OF OWNERSHIP OF LOT NO. 1NEW-1, BLOCK NO. 2, TRACT 1427 LOCATED IN THE MUNICIPALITIES OF BARRIGADA AND DEDEDO FROM THE GUAM INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT AUTHORITY TO THE CHAMORRO LAND TRUST COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds 2 that many applicants and participants of the Chamorro Land Trust Commission 3 (CLTC) are unable to secure the financial means for the costs associated with the 4 required infrastructure necessary for the installation of power, water, and telephone 5 services for the construction of a new dwelling. Many qualified applicants have 6 been forced to delay the process of building their homes as a result. I Liheslatura 7 finds that this ultimately defeats the mission of the CLTC thus undermining the 8 quality of life for those seeking the opportunity to become homeowners. 9

I Liheslatura finds that Lot No. 1NEW-1, Block No. 2, Tract 1427, was transferred to the Guam International Airport Authority (Airport) for the development of industrial operations directly related to airport operations. *I Liheslatura* further finds that the operation and commission of a lease to a fuel service station for which the Airport receives rental income does not have any direct relation to the operations of the Airport.

I Liheslatura wishes to transfer the property and lease of the fuel service station whose services are not directly related to airport operations to the CLTC, in order to support the development of basic infrastructure of CLTC properties to make them habitable.

20 Section 2. Transfer of Title. Title to and jurisdiction over the parcel of real property in the municipalities of Barrigada and Dededo encompassing Lot No. 21 1NEW-1, Block No. 2, Tract 1427 containing an area of 61,449± Square Feet or 22 5,709± Square Meters presently under lease for the operations of a fuel service 23 facility is hereby transferred from the Guam International Airport Authority to the 24 Chamorro Land Trust Commission which shall act as sole administrator of the 25 lease to this parcel and shall receive all payments thereunder. All other terms of the 26 lease agreement executed prior to January 1, 2011 (the "Lease") between the lessee 27 and the Airport shall remain in effect, except that references to the Guam 28 International Airport Authority shall be deemed to refer to the Chamorro Land 29 Trust Commission. 30

Section 3. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon enactment.

32 Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this Law or its application to any 33 person or circumstances is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity 34 *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Law which can be given 35 effect without the invalid provisions or application and to this end the provisions of 36 this Act are severable.
