COMMENTS TO BILL 56-32(COR)

BILL NO. 39-32 IS AN ACT RELAVTIVE TO REPEALING AND REENACTING SECTION §9108 OF TITLE 16, OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED.

The Bill is proposing to impose a fine not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) in violation of any provisions as set forth in Title 16, Chapter 9. This is in when no such fine exist in the "schedule of fines" adopted by the Traffic Court Division of the Superior Court of Guam or by the Judiciary Branch. As such, this could serve as an additional revenue generating source to the Superior Court of Guam. However, the annual financial impact is undetermined at this time.
