#### BUREAU OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT RESEARCH COMMENTS ON BILL NO. <u>68-32 (COR)</u>

The proposed legislation is aimed at authorizing the I Maga'lahen Guåhan, the Governor, to exchange a portion of government property, specifically Tract 11405 (formerly Lot. No. 10120-20), to Mr. Samuel and Mrs. Min-jung Sparks as compensation for the construction of a ponding basin on a portion of their property, specifically Lot No. 3255-6-R4 on a value-for-value basis.

The construction of said basin was in response to alleviating the flooding in the area of Naki Street in Chalan Pago and serve as a Route 4 water runoff collector. The Department of Public Works and the landowners have stated that the construction (government operated) "occurred without any consent by the Sparks or condemnation of the private land by the government for public use, and there has been no compensation paid by the government" after more than twenty years of use of the land.

The proposed legislation requires the lands subject to exchange be appraised, surveyed, mapped, and registered. According to the Department of Land Management, it will be impacted financially with the cost of appraisals, survey, mapping, and registration in the amount of \$8,000.00.
