2	Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. <i>I Liheslaturan Guahan</i> finds that on
3	June 28, 2012, the Port Board of Directors approved the issuance of RFP No. 12-014,
4	soliciting the services of a commercial lending institution for the financing of the Port's
5	service life extension (SLE) repairs on the Port's wharf, and procurement of a financial
6	management system and a container top lifter with the total amount, not to exceed Ten
7	Million Dollars (\$10,000,000)
8	I Liheslatura further finds that on September 14, 2012 GEDA issued RFP No.
9	12-014 and received three responses to the proposal. The Bank of Guam was given the
10	highest rating amongst the bidders. On October 26, 2012, the Negotiation Team initially
11	met with Bank of Guam for the negotiation of terms and conditions. On November 6,
12	2012, GEDA awarded the Bank of Guam as the financial institution to provide the
13	services.
14	I Liheslatura further finds that on January 22, 2013, the Bank of Guam informed
