Comments:

Bill 87-32 amends Section 3305 of Ch. 3 of 16GCA requiring drivers and passengers, regardless of age, to wear a
helmet. The number of violators below the age of 18 relative to the imposed fine of \$50 - \$500 is the anticipated
increase in revenues. The Bureau has requested data from the Department of Revenue and Taxation; however,
information has not been received as of these comments.
