The Bureau requests that Bill No(s). 120-33 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 120-33 (COR): An act to amend §77112 of Article 1, Chapter 77, Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, relative to authorized events and activities at Paseo Stadium and the Jose C. Guerrero Field in Hagåtña, Guam.

This bill proposes to amend by adding §77112 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, Paseo Stadium and the Jose C. Guerrero Field in Hagåtña, shall not be used for events and activities unrelated to baseball and other sports on Guam. The Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation, or his authorized designee, shall ensure that all sports-related events and activities, as sanctioned by the department, do not adversely affect the playing fields, facilities, and areas of Paseo Stadium and the Jose C. Guerrero Field.

The intent of the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
