Per the proposed amendment to §8114.1 of Chapter 8, Title 7, Guam Code Annotated, full-time government of Guam employees may now join the "Volunteer Deputy Marshal Reserve" program. Per 8114.3 volunteers shall be compensated stipend for a minimum of forty-two (42) hours or more per month. Therefore, the impact would be determined on the basis of completing the 42 hours or more a month and the rate of compensation. Absent information on the number of volunteers and the rate of stipend applied, the Bureau is unable to determine an estimated impact at this time.
