The Bureau requests that Bill No(s). 146-33 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 146-33 (COR) is an act to add a new § 832.1 to Article 1 of Chapter 8, Title 1, Guam Code Annotated, relative to the establishment of a War on Terror Fallen Heroes Monument on the Adelup Parade Field in the Ricardo J. Bordallo Governor's Complex at Adelup; and to repeal Public Law 32-046.

The intent of the Bill poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam. The Monument would occupy land space not to exceed more than twenty feet (20') in length and twenty feet (20') in width. All expenses incurred for project construction and monument maintenance will be covered one-hundred percent (100%) by the Fallen Heroes of the Pacific (Guam).

AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW § 832.1 TO ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 8, TITLE 1, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A WAR ON TERROR FALLEN HEROES MONUMENT ON THE ADELUP PARADE FIELD IN THE RICARDO J. BORDALLO GOVERNOR'S COMPLEX AT ADELUP; AND TO *REPEAL* PUBLIC LAW 32-046.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that Public Law 32-046 was signed into law on July 05, 2013, authorizing the Fallen Heroes of the Pacific Foundation (Guam) to erect a memorial monument in the Skinner Plaza, Hagåtña.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that the Fallen Heroes of the Pacific Foundation (Guam) has requested to relocate the monument from the Skinner's Plaza to the Adelup Parade Field in the Ricardo J. Bordallo Governor's Complex at Adelup to memorialize and pay tribute to the men and women who have made the ultimate sacrifice; and to provide a place of solemnity and contemplation for everyone.

Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to relocate the War on Terror Fallen Heroes Monument from the Skinner's Plaza to the Adelup Parade Field in the Ricardo J. Bordallo Governor's Complex at Adelup by *adding* a new § 832.1 to Article 1, Chapter 8, Title 1, Guam Code Annotated, and by *repealing* Public Law 32-046.

1 **Section 2.** A new §832.1 is hereby *added* to Article 1 of Chapter 8, Title
2 1, Guam Code Annotated, to read as follows:

3 **"§ 832.1. War on Terror Fallen Heroes Monument.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Fallen Heroes of the Pacific
5 Foundation (Guam) is hereby authorized to erect a memorial monument on
6 the Adelup Parade Field in the Ricardo J. Bordallo Governor's Complex at
7 Adelup, in honor of Guam's men and women of the U S. Armed Forces in
8 the War on Terror, to include Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation
9 Enduring Freedom, who have courageously and selflessly served our island
10 and our nation; and who have made the ultimate sacrifice.

11 The Fallen Heroes of the Pacific Foundation in the preparation and
12 construction of the War on Terror Fallen Heroes Monument shall comply
13 with the following provisions:

14 (a) occupy a land space *not to exceed* more than twenty feet (20') in
15 length and twenty feet (20') in width within the Ricardo J. Bordallo
16 Governor's Complex at Adelup;

17 (b) submit to the office of the Governor the plan and design of the
18 monument for approval by executive order. The monument *shall* include, at
19 a minimum and as provided for in this Chapter, the names of Guam's Fallen
20 Heroes and the branch served in the U.S. Armed Forces; and

21 (c) *shall not* hold the government of Guam liable or responsible for
22 any expenses related to the construction and maintenance of the monument
23 authorized herein."

24 **Section 3. Repeal of Public Law 32-046.** Public Law 32-046 is hereby
25 *repealed.*
