Bill No. 146-33 (COR) is an act to add a new § 832.1 to Article 1 of Chapter 8, Title 1, Guam Code Annotated, relative to the establishment of a War on Terror Fallen Heroes Monument on the Adelup Parade Field in the Ricardo J. Bordallo Governor's Complex at Adelup; and to repeal Public Law 32-046.

The intent of the Bill poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam. BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds
- 3 that Public Law 32-046 was signed into law on July 05, 2013, authorizing the
- 4 Fallen Heroes of the Pacific Foundation (Guam) to erect a memorial monument in
- 5 the Skinner Plaza, Hagåtna.
- 6 I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that the Fallen Heroes of the Pacific
- 7 Foundation (Guam) has requested to relocate the monument from the Skinner's
