The Bureau requests that Bill No(s). 190-33 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 190-33 (COR) is an act to amend Section 9(c) of Public Law 32-054, relative to requiring that the National Clinical Mental Health Counselor Exam is the sole requisite exam for licensure for Licensed Mental Health Counselor; and to amend Sections 1, 2, 8,9, and 16 of P.L. 32-054 for purposes of establishing a licensed intern designation during the three thousand (3,000) hour post-graduate clinical experience period required for mental health professional licensure.

The intent of the aforementioned bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
