1/ Per information received from a Judiciary of Guam staff, only a limited amount of applicants are expected to file a petition of expungement and if the applicant meets all the requirements for expungement, the Judge may make a ruling without a court hearing. As such, associated cost, probably to be absorbed under the Judiciary's operational budget, such as administrative and supply requirements for the printing and processing of applications, is estimated to be minimal.
