The Bureau requests that Bill No(s). <u>222-33(COR)</u> be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 222-33 (COR) is an act to amend Sections 6207 and 6207.1 of and to add new Sections 6218.2 and 6218.3 to Chapter 6, Title 4 of the Guam Code Annotated, relative to prohibiting bonus pay and mandating proper pay and pay adjustment processing for unclassified employee.

Amendments to §§6207 and 6207.1 would require that salaries for positions within the offices of the Governor and Lieutenant Governor (which are not set by law) shall be paid in twenty-six (26) equal installments from the effective date when such salary was set. The Bill also adds new §§6218.2 and 6218.3 to Chapter 6 of 4 GCA which prohibits bonuses to unclassified employees and remedies for repayment in the event that base pay for such employees occurs contrary to the aforementioned sections of Chapter 6 of 4 GCA.

The intent of the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
