COMMENTS to Bill No. 241-33 (COR):

The Bill is proposing to establish a Recycling Industry Economic Stimulus program that will provide recycling companies who qualify Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each ton of solid waste recycled. Per the Bill, current private recycling companies licensed by GEPA recycle about an estimated 42,000 tons of recyclable material each year. If this level of recyclable materials is maintained, the annual estimated payout will be \$1,260,000.

In addition, the Bill adds to the Continuing Appropriation provisions under the Recycling Revolving Fund to include the following items to be continually funded:

- (i) Recycling Industry Economic Stimulus Program \$1,260,000 (as noted above)
- (ii) One (1) FTE to administer the program Position currently filled by a Special Projects Coordinator (Salary and Benefits) \$61,180
- (iii) Contract to promote recycling in the community \$100,000
- (iv) Contract to implement a Zero Waste Tolerance program \$300,000

Per information received from a discussion with a GEPA staff, the fund averages about \$250,000 a month (from monthly vehicle registration fees) equating to an estimated revenue collections of \$3,000,000 annually. Please note that the amount reported of \$777,829 on the "Unreserved Balance" of the "Fund Source Information" of the Fiscal Note form is based on an updated Balance Sheet for the Fund provided by the Department of Administration for the period up until 2/22/16 (unaudited). If revenue collections track for the remaining seven (7) months, it would be sufficient to support the Bill's proposal for the remaining FY2016 estimated at \$1,004,022.
