Comments on Bill No. 243-33 (COR)

The intent of the proposed legislation is to authorize I Maga'Lahen Guahan, I Segundo Maga'Lahen Guahan and individual senators to voluntarily reduce their salaries and funds saved from the reduction of salaries shall be deposited into the Healthy Futures Fund.

Based on the Competitive Wage Act of 2014, the salary increases are as follows:

- I Maga Lahen Guahan from \$90,000 to \$130,000 per annum (increase of \$40,000)
- I Segundo Maga'Lahen Guahan from \$85,000 to \$110,000 per annum (increase of \$25,000)
- Senators from \$65,000 to \$85,000 per annum (increase of \$20,000). A total of \$300,000 for 15
 Senators

Should all fifteen (15) senators, I Maga'Lahen Guahan, and I Segundo Maga'Lahen Guahan voluntarily reduce their salaries back to the original level prior to the Competitive Wage Act of 2014, the total cost savings would be \$365,000 (excluding benefits). The projected cost savings for the reminder of FY2016 (16 pay periods) is approximately \$224,615 (excluding benefits).

However, funds not utilized for salaries of the officials identified should remain within the same fund, namely the General Fund.
