The proposed measure is to add a new §10315 to Chapter 10, Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated, whereby the Guam Board of Medical Examiners shall publish and update on a quarterly basis on its website a listing of licenses issued by the Guam Board of Medical Examiners including the holder's name, primary work address, phone number, specialty, initial date of licensure, license status and board certifications.

The intent of the proposed measure is administrative in nature and, as such, poses no fiscal impact to any funds of the government of Guam.
