COMMENTS ON BILL NO. 275-33 (COR)

According to information received from the Guam Economic Development Authority (GEDA), Bill 275-33 aims to enhance the operations of the Guam Fishermen's Cooperative Association (GFCA) by providing \$1M in additional funding to allow for the construction of an active loading and off-loading facility that complements the GFCA facility which has already been provided \$2M from the Hotel Occupancy Tax Bond Proceeds, Series 2011A.

Bill 275-33 if enacted into law, places the Dock Facility and Shoreline Reinforcement Economic Enhancement Project of the GFCA Facility under a new section §1515(i)(2)(B)(v). This placement increases the total appropriation for the GFCA facility from \$5 Million to \$6 Million. GEDA notes that it did not have available the original \$5 Million appropriated for the GFCA facility, but was able to free up \$2 Million in funding by managing the scopes of work for projects that allowed reduction of small amounts from various other Hot Bond projects, and by not implementing the purchase of Faifai and Gognga (Gun Beach) due to insufficient funding.

At the present time, GEDA does not have \$1 Million from "unused appropriations" under the Hot Bond and must await the completion of remaining Hot Bond projects to ascertain the amount available, even though placement under section §1515(i)(2)(B)(v) gives the dock and shoreline reinforcement project a higher priority than the GFCA facility itself. GEDA anticipates construction of the GFCA facility itself, can proceed without the immediate construction of the dock and shoreline reinforcement project. GEDA estimates the fiscal impact of Bill 275-33 to be an additional \$1 Million (\$6M minus \$5M).
