Footnotes:

Per information from the PDSC, under its current Board of Trustees composition, only <u>appointed</u> Board members are entitled to stipends. With the proposed change per the Bill, the <u>appointed</u> Board members will increase from 2 to 4. The PDSC noted that the Board meets once a month at \$50.00 per member. Therefore, the estimated funding requirement for stipends will increase by 50% from \$1,200 to \$2,400 (4 appointed Board members x \$50/month x 12 months). The estimated cost for the remaining 5 months of the fiscal year is \$1,000. This additional cost for Board stipends will have to be absorbed under the PDSC's annual operating budget.
