## BUREAU OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT RESEARCH COMMENTS ON BILL NO. 315-33 (COR)

The proposed legislation intends to transfer a portion of Lot No. 5075-REM-A NEW-1 in the municipality of Tamuning (approx. 5,686± square meters) from the Chamorro Land Trust Commission (CLTC) to the Guam Waterworks Authority (GWA) for the purpose of constructing new water storage tanks.

Sections 2(a) and 2(b) stipulate that the GWA will be responsible for covering the cost of the appraisal of the property by two different appraisers as well as the cost of the property survey that shall be approved and recorded by the Department of Land Management (DLM).

Although compensation for the transfer of CLTC property to the GWA is not specifically outlined, Section 2(c) stipulates that the two parties will determine the appropriate method of compensation to include, but not limited to, a land exchange, in-kind services, purchase, or a combination of the listed options. All compensation options shall be approved by the GWA, CLTC, and the Consolidated Commission on Utilities (CCU). The compensation agreement between the GWA and CLTC must be finalized within 180 days after the enactment of the proposed legislation.

Because the GWA does not receive appropriations from the Government of Guam, having GWA cover the cost of the appraisals and survey of the subject property will not have an impact on any of the Government of Guam's finances.

As previously mentioned, the CLTC will receive an appropriate compensation for the transfer of the subject property. However, because the specific terms of compensation have not been outlined or agreed upon at the time of preparing comments, the Bureau is unable to determine if the compensation is equal, more, or less than the value of the subject property.

#### Hafa Adai!

The Department of Land Management and the Chamorro Land Trust Commission (CLTC) have reviewed Bill No. 315-33. The CLTC board of commissioners, in Resolution No. 2016-02, approved the intent of this bill to provide the Guam Waterworks Authority (GWA) with land necessary for the development of water infrastructure which is in the public interest.

Nevertheless, compensation for the land is necessary but due to the immediate need for GWA to acquire the property and begin construction of infrastructure facilities, the period of 180 days is adequate time to determine the best manner of compensation. Equally, GWA would be responsible for all costs associated with this land transfer.

As shown in the exhibits to this bill, both the CLTC and GWA respective boards of commissioners have issued resolutions supporting this measure. Additionally, each have been working collaboratively because water is a necessary element for everyone. Just as many water wells and potential sites reside on CLTC property, both agencies have worked together to ensure the availability and protection of these water sources. In the same way, both agencies have been cooperative in ensuring CLTC lessees' utility authorization requests are honored and managed as expeditiously as possible.

However, there are a few technical issues with the wording of Bill No. 315-33 which may be errors in transcription:

a. Make the following changes to Section 1, page 1, line 3:

I Liheslaturan Guahan finds that the Guam Waterworks Authority (GWA) has identified property, owned by the Chamorro Land Trust Commission (CLTC), for the purpose of providing a staging area during the construction of a new water reservoir, preparing the site for the future construction of an additional 2MG reservoir, and for the relocation of an existing pump station: constructing a new detention basin which will allow for the replacement of the existing one (1) million gallon water storage and for the construction of an above ground two (2) million gallons water storage reservoir.

- b. Make corrections in Section 1, page 2, line 9:
  - 1) Remove "1,852" and replace with "5,686"
  - 2) Remove "0.446" and replace with "1.40"

Lastly, the Department of Land Management requests the inclusion of language in this bill to rezone Lot 5075-REM-A NEW-1, Tamuning, to zoning designation "PF" (Public Facility), in accordance with 21GCA, Chapter 61, Section 61313.

Bill No. 315-33 is intended to serve the needs of the public and a land transfer is necessary. The CLTC recommends passage of this bill.
