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BUREAU OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT RESEARCH COMMENTS ON BILL NO. 32-33 (COR)

The intent of the proposed legislation is to add a new §1515(i)(2)(B)(v) to Article 5, Chapter 1, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated relative to the inclusion of the project to demolish the Manuel F.L. Guerrero Administration Building to the list of projects funded by HOT Bonds (HOT Bond Law – P.L. 30-228). The projects funded by the HOT Bond Law are known as the Historic Hagatna projects.

Per the Guam Economic Development Authority (GEDA), the current projects listed in Article 5, Chapter 1, Title 5, GCA are anticipated to lapse in funds. It is GEDA's intent to request that the Legislature amend the cited law to include the demolition of the former Department of Administration Building. The cost of the demolition project will be funded by the lapsed funding from the projects currently listed in the cited law.

The Bureau has determined that there will be no adverse financial impact to fund the demolition project with lapsed funding from other Historic Hagatna projects. However, if lapsed funding is insufficient to cover the full cost of the demolition project, an alternate fund source would have to be identified. Currently, there is no mention of an alternative fund source in the proposed legislation.
