Bureau of Budget and Management Research Comments on Bill No. 327-33 (COR)

The proposed legislation intends to amend the composition of the Supreme Court, Superior Court, and Judicial Council of the Unified Judiciary of Guam. If the Bill were to amend Subsection 3103(a), of Chapter 3, Division 1 of Title 7 GCA, it would change the composition of the Supreme Court to comprise of two (2) additional full-time Justices, shifting the number of seats on the bench from three (3) to five (5). In addition, amending Subsection 4104(a) of Chapter 4, Division 1 of Title 7 GCA would likewise increase the number of Superior Court judges from seven (7) to eight (8).

Based on information provided by the Judiciary of Guam, it is estimated to cost \$496,162. for one (1) newly appointed Supreme Court Justice and \$399,362 for one (1) Superior Court judge for the first year, to include salary and benefits, support staff, courtroom equipment, supplies, and non-recurring start-up expenses. Furthermore, it will cost \$456,787 for one (1) Supreme Court Justice and \$373,612 for one (1) Superior Court judge per year after the first year with the removal of non-recurring start-up expenses. With the addition of two (2) more justices and one (1) judge, there will be a fiscal impact of approximately \$1,391,686 for the first year and \$1,287,186 per year thereafter should the Bill be enacted into law. It should be noted that there are potential expansion costs that may be incurred for their additional chambers and courtrooms. These costs are not factored into the aforementioned estimates.
