Footnotes: Bill 363-33 provides a framework for individuals, businesses, and the Government of Guam to participate in self-generation of renewable energy through a community-based renewable energy construct. Participants will be able to receive credits through their utility bills for the electricity they generate. The Bureau notes the fiscal impact resulting from the passage of the Bill would likely affect the operations and revenue streams of the Guam Power Authority. Any Impact to the general fund will be from Income Tax and Business Privilege Taxes generated from economic activity; however, the Bureau is unable to determine such impact at this time. The Guam Power Authority was contacted and feedback requested; however, data has not been received as of these comments.
