Bill 371-33 will amend §1515(i) of Article 5, Chapter 1 of Title 5 GCA for the purpose of lifting the appropriation cap of \$27 Million for construction, equipping and furnishing the Guam and Chamorro Educational Facility (GCEF) which will allow the GEDA to supplement funding for the GCEF through internal transfers of funds using available proceeds from savings in other HOT Bond projects. As was noted in their letter dated September 6, 2016 to the *I Liheslaturan Gudhan*, the GEDA anticipates that \$800,000 is needed to complete the Senator Antonio "Tony" Palamo Guam and Educational Facility project, to pay for cost increases for museum exhibits, media production, new signage to reflect the museum's new name and new construction requirements.
