1/ Bill 398-33 (COR) proposes to appropriate a total of \$150,000 from the FY2016 Tourist Attraction Fund's fund balance. Appropriations are to the Guam Visitors Bureau (GVB) on behalf of the Hurao Academy to develop a language immersion pre-school program. The Department of Administration provided BBMR with a report showing an unaudited fund balance of \$1,726,289. However, with outstanding encumbrances, continuing appropriations and Mayor's Council appropriations for FY2016 totaling \$2,928,109, the adjusted fund balance as of 9/30/16 is (\$1,201,820). Funds are not available to cover the proposed appropriation in this bill.
