Notes:
1/ The proposed legislation would require that the lowest bidder for each Government of Guam Group Health Insurance Plan (GHIP) be determined as the designated rate split of Government of Guam contributions for the GHIP. The proposed legislation stipulates that the lowest bidder of the Health Savings Account (HSA) 2000 plans was also selected as the rate split for the Preferred Provider Organization (PPO) 1500 plans. However, the lowest bidder of the HSA2000 plans may not have been the lowest bidder for the PPO1500 plan, making the Government of Guam contribution for the PPO1500 plan higher than it should be. Passage of the proposed legislation would lower each Government of Guam agency/department's cost obligation for employees that are covered under the PPO1500 plan. The Bureau is unable to determine an estimated amount of savings resulting from the change of rate split for the Government of Guam's contribution to the GHIP due to the lowest bidder of the PPO1500 plan not being identified in the proposed legislation.
