1/ The proposed legislation authorizes the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS), Division of Environmental Health, to expend the unexpended balance of funds to the Controlled Substances Diversion Fund. Per information from the DPHSS, the funds will be utilized to procure training, investigative tools, and other items and services to support the Controlled Sustances Program and Prescription Drug Monitoring Program in order to combat the diversion of pharmaceutical controlled substances. The appropriation level carried forward into FY2015 total \$23,969.07 (\$21,850.19-unaliotted balance and \$2,118.88-ontstanding encumbrances).
