Footnotes:

1/: The subject legislation proposes to transfer the waste water pump stations located on the campuses of the Southern High School and the Luis P. Untulan Middle School. In so doing, operations and maintenance costs of these pump stations would be transferred from the Guam Department of Education (GDOE) to the GWA. This would result in reduced costs to GDOE and to the General Fund. Per the Bureau's research, estimated annual operations and maintenance costs is approximately \$25,000 per waste water pump station. This excludes costs (if any) to bring the aforementioned pump stations up to operation standards. Absent additional information from the Authority, it is uncertain if the proposed legislation will impact rate payers of GWA.
