Footnotes: 1/ The proposed legislation seeks to declare June 28th of each year as a special holiday known as the "War Survivor Day" in recognition of the Chamorro people who have gone before us, to celebrate the lives of those still with us and to remind fature generations to be seen forget the legacy and heritage of our war survivors who suffered trugic and horrific enemy occupations. In a recent PDN article (5/8/2015), it is stated that the War Survivor Day would not be considered an official Government of Guam holiday and thus, would not cost the taxpayers. However, the new provision states that the Governor shall appoint a War Survivor Day Committee to plan and make appropriate arrangements for the commemoration of this day. Therefore, it may entail a potential fiscal impact which may include but no limited to site rental (indoor or outdoor), caterer, photographer, supplies (ie. rental of chairs, tables, canopies), publicity and invitations to the event, signs and banners and entertainment. It is noted that the Bill adds a new Section 1037 to Chapter 10 of Title 1 GCA, however, the listing of holidays on Guam are under \$1000.
