BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Appropriation. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the sum of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000.00) escheated to

4 the General Fund at the end of Fiscal Year 2012 and is available for

5 appropriations in Fiscal Year 2013, pursuant to §21116 of Chapter 21,

6 Division 2, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby appropriated to the
