#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Appropriation. Notwithstanding any other provision of
- 3 law, unexpended funds escheated to the General Fund at the end of Fiscal
- 4 Year 2012 and are available for appropriation in Fiscal Year 2013, pursuant
- 5 to §21116 of Chapter 21, Division 2, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, are
