



AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 162102 OF CHAPTER 162, TITLE 11 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO THE COLLECTIVE INVESTMENT FUNDS ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 162102 of Chapter 162, Title 11 Guam Code Annotated is hereby amended to read:

"§ 162102. Establishment of Collective Investment Funds. A financial institution may establish and maintain collective investment funds for the investment of assets of retirement, pension, profit sharing, stock bonus or other trusts that are exempt from federal income tax, and may invest assets of retirement, pension, profit sharing, stock bonus, or other employee benefit trusts exempt from federal income tax, and that the financial institution holds in any capacity (including agent) in such collective investment funds, maintained pursuant to 45 USC §80(c)(10) (B) 15 USC §80a-3(c)(11).

Section 2. Severability. If any provision of this Law or its application to any person or circumstances is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Law which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
