1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. "TITLE 3 GCA § 13106. Events Causing Vacancy in the
- 3 Municipal Offices of Mayor and Vice Mayor" is amended to read:
- 4 "The municipal offices of mayor and vice mayor become vacant on
- 5 the happening of any of the following events:
- 6 (a) death of the incumbent;
- 7 (b) declaration of mental incompetence by a final judgment or
- 8 final order of a court of competent jurisdiction;
- 9 (c) resignation from office;
- 10 (d) refusal or failure to assume office;

T	(e) the decision of a competent tribunal deciaring void his of			
2	her election;			
3	(f) conviction of a felony, or of a crime involving moral			
4	turpitude;			
5	(g) his or her change of residence from the municipality in			
6	which he or she was elected;			
7	(h) when an incumbent is incapacitated because of illness and			
8	unable to continue for the remainder of the term to which he or she			
9	was elected; or			
10	(i) when an incumbent has sought and won election to another			
11	office and assumed the new office, constituting voluntary			
12	relinquishment of the original office.			
13	The occurrence of any event under (a) through (i), with respect			
14	to a person or persons elected to office, after the election but before			
15	the term of office is to commence, constitutes a vacancy on the date			
16	the term commences, unless the person or persons so elected is the			
17	incumbent, in which case, the vacancy occurs on the date of such			
18	event."			
19	Section 2. A new § 13107 is added to TITLE 3 GCA Chapter 13.			
20	Existing §§ 13107-13108 are renumbered accordingly.			

"13107. Special Election to fill a Vacancy or Vacancies in the Municipal Offices of Guam Mayors and Vice Mayors. The Guam Election Commission shall call for a special election on a Saturday on or about sixty (60) days after a vacancy occurs in an office of Mayor or Vice Mayor, whenever one (1) or more vacancies occur therein 240 days or more *prior* to the date of the next general election for Mayors and Vice Mayors. There shall be no primary election. Candidates must file their candidacies no later than thirty (30) days prior to the special election date. The highest vote-getter (or vote-getters if there is more than one [1] vacancy), shall be certified by the Guam Election Commission as elected and shall be administered the oath of office immediately to fill the unexpired vacancy. If both Mayor and Vice Mayor offices are vacant, resulting in a special election for two [2] vacancies, the highest vote-getter shall become the Mayor-Elect, and the second highest shall become the Vice Mayor-Elect."

Section 3. Section 6105 (b) of Title 3 Guam Code Annotated Chapter 6 is amended to read:

"§ 6105. Person Eligible for Only One (1) Office.

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(a) No person shall be eligible for more than one (1) elective office to be filled in the same election. The term "election" as used in this Section

- 1 includes a general and a local election held on the same date, so as to
- 2 prohibit a person from running for office in a local election and in a general
- 3 election at the same time.
- 4 (b) No person shall be eligible for an office to be filled in an election if
- 5 sixty (60) days prior to the primary he or she is holding another elective
- 6 office, the term of which will not expire on or prior to the date of
- 7 commencement of the term of office for which he or she is running, with
- 8 the exception of any elective office for which a special election would be
- 9 required in the event of a vacancy."
- Section 4. "Title 5 GCA Chapter 40 § 40110, "Vacancies," items (a)
- and (b) are amended, and item (c) is deleted, to read:
- 12 "§ 40110. Vacancies. "(a) Vice-Mayors. A vacancy in the office
- of the Vice-Mayor less than 240 days before the date of the next
- 14 general election for Mayors and Vice-Mayors shall be filled for the
- 15 unexpired term by [Haga'lahi (the Governor) by appointment after
- soliciting the non-binding recommendations of a majority vote of the
- Municipal Planning Council of the municipality in which the vacancy
- occurs, subject to the advice and consent of I Liheslatura (the
- 19 Legislature).

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"(b) Mayors. If by reason of death, resignation, removal from

office, inability or failure to perform, there shall be a vacancy in the office of the Mayor [, it shall be filled for the unexpired term.] less than 240 days before the date of the next general election for Mayors and Vice-Mayors, it shall be filled The vacancy shall be filled by I Maga'lahi (the Governor) by appointment after soliciting the nonbinding recommendations of the Municipal Planning Council of the municipality in which the vacancy occurred, subject to the advice and consent of I Liheslatura (the Legislature); provided, however, that by the Vice-Mayor in a municipality where there is a Vice-Mayor, [the Vice Mayor shall automatically assume the position of Mayor] and there shall be a vacancy in the position of Vice-Mayor until the end of the term. In a municipality where there is no Vice-Mayor and the vacancy is less than 240 days before the date of the next general election for Mayors and Vice-Mayors, the vacancy shall be filled by a majority vote of the Municipal Planning Council of the municipality in which the vacancy occurs, subject to the advice and consent of I Liheslatura (the Legislature)." [The vacancy shall be filled by I Maga'lahi (the Governor) by appointment after soliciting the nonbinding recommendations of the Municipal Planning Council of the municipality in which the vacancy occurred, subject to the advice and

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consent of I Liheslatura (the Legislature); provided, however, that in a municipality where there is a Vice-Mayor, the Vice-Mayor shall automatically assume the position of Mayor and there shall be a vacancy in the position of Vice-Mayor.

(c) Temporary vacancy. If there is a temporary vacancy greater than thirty (30) days in the office of Mayor, caused by other than official business, and there is no Vice-Mayor, the vacancy shall be filled by the Governor by appointment after soliciting the non-binding recommendations of the Municipal Planning Council of the municipality.
