1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guahån* finds
3 the Taga'chang Beach Park Main Pavilion, under the administrative authority
4 of the Office of the Mayor of Yona, pursuant to Public Law No. 31-162, is in an
5 advanced state of disrepair as to endanger the health, safety and welfare of
6 the citizens of the community and determined that legislative appropriation is
7 necessary to abate the nuisance thereby permitted to exist by reason of its
8 hazardous condition.

9 *I Liheslaturan Guahån* further finds that both the Department of Public
10 Works and Occupational Safety and Health Administration have made an

1 assessment of the conditions and have determined the building to be
2 structurally unsafe and recommended it be demolished.

3 **Section 2. Appropriation.**

4 The sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) is hereby
5 appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of the Mayor of Yona for the
6 sole purpose of funding the demolition and disposal of the Taga'chang Beach
7 Park Main Pavilion. Such appropriation shall not lapse and shall remain
8 available pursuant to this act until fully expended.
