**BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

**Section 1. Increments for GMH Employees.** The sum of One Million Four

Hundred Ninety Nine Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,499,500) from the General

Fund is hereby appropriated to the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority to fund the

payment of increments owed to the GMH employees from the period 10/1/2012 to

07/17/2013.

**Section 2. Section 1, Chapter XV of Public Law 32-181 is hereby *amended* to**

**read:**

**“Section 1. Appropriation for Executive Branch Vacancies.** The sum of ~~Three~~

~~Million Seventy Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy One Dollars (\$3,077,971)~~ One Million

Five Hundred Seventy Eight Thousand Four Hundred Seventy One Dollars (1,578,471)

1 is appropriated from the General Fund to the vacancies for Executive Branch Agencies  
2 and Departments Cost Pool Account pursuant to Section 2 of this Chapter for funded  
3 vacancies for Fiscal Year 2015 to the following departments and agencies: BBMR,  
4 DOA, DRT,DOL, AGR, GBHWC, and/or DPR.”

5 **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any  
6 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall not  
7 affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect without the  
8 invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.

9 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* become immediately effective upon  
10 enactment.
