BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the sum of Four
- 3 Million Dollars (\$4,000,000) is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated,
- 4 unallocated fund balance of the Tourist Attraction Fund and from the surplus
- balance of the 2007 General Obligation Bonds Series A, for the following:
- 6 (a) Guam Police Department (GPD). The amount of One Million Five
- 7 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000) shall be allocated to GPD for the payment
- 8 of overtime costs, including prior year.
- 9 **(b) Department of Corrections (DOC).** The amount of One Million
- Dollars (\$1,000,000) shall be allocated to DOC for the payment of overtime costs,
- including prior year.
- (c) Guam Fire Department (GFD). The amount of One Million Five
- Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000) shall be allocated to GFD for the payment
- of overtime costs, including prior year.
