1           WHEREAS, his parents blessed him with his siblings James  
2   K. L. Yee of Kaneohe, HI., Kim Ping Yee of Waipahu, HI., and  
3   Bernice Baily of Kaneohe, HI.; and

4           WHEREAS, Kim Yee attended Waipahu High School  
5   (Waipahu, HI.) from 1941-45 and Graduated; and

6           WHEREAS, Kim Yee while attending high school earned 36  
7   cents per hour, as a part-time laborer; and

8           WHEREAS, December 6, 1945 was his first day as a federal  
9   worker and that date serves as his Federal Service Computation  
10   Date (SCD); and

11          WHEREAS, he joined the U.S. Army in 1945 thru 1946 and  
12   received an Honorable Discharge from active duty from the 82nd  
13   Airborne, All-American Division and earned \$50 per Month while  
14   being stationed at Ft. Bragg, N.C. and performed over 50  
15   paratrooper drops during his enlistment; and

16          WHEREAS, in 1946 Kim Yee began his career with the U.S.  
17   Navy at the Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard in Honolulu, HI. , as a  
18   Sheet Metal Worker in Shop 17; and

1           WHEREAS, in 1946 was hired by the Civil Aeronautics  
2 Administration [CAA] of the U.S. Department of Commerce and  
3 arrived on Guam in 1948,

4           WHEREAS, during his career, he has received numerous  
5 Special Act and Service Awards as well as Performance, Time-Off  
6 and Monetary Awards, as an Electronics Technician (GS-856-12)  
7 and eventually held the position as an Airway Transportation  
8 System Specialist [ATSS] (FV-2101-H) with the Air Traffic  
9 Organization – Technical Operations [ATO-W]; Western Service  
10 Area [WSA]; and

11           WHEREAS, Kim Yee’s hobbies continue to be Golfing and  
12 Gardening; and

13           WHEREAS, Kim Yee remains an instrumental part in the  
14 daily operations with the Federal Aviation Administration [FAA]  
15 on Guam; now, therefore be it

17 does hereby congratulate Kim Yee on his outstanding contribution  
18 with the FAA and to the people of Guam, and be it further
