




3 WHEREAS, James Michael Santos Artero was born on June 1, 1981 to
4 James Michael Flores Artero and Theresa S. Witt; and

5 WHEREAS, James Michael Santos Artero attended school at P.C. Lujan
6 Middle School in Radio Barrigada, Inarajan High School, and graduated in
7 1999 from Guam Community College; and

8 WHEREAS, in order to serve his country, James Michael Santos Artero
9 enlisted in the United States Navy in the year 2000; and

10 WHEREAS, his fortitude to succeed in his career prompted outstanding
11 performance evaluations from his superiors, and a number of medals of
12 commendation; and

13 WHEREAS, James Michael Santos was awarded the National Defense

1 Service Medal on September 11, 2001; the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal
2 on February 6, and March 3, 2003; the Global War on Terrorism Award on
3 March 8, 2003; the Sea Service Award on April 6, 2003; a Good Conduct
4 Award on September 9, 2003; and a Navy Unit Commendation on March 3,
5 2004 and May 3, 2004; and

6 **WHEREAS**, in the last evaluation given to Michael James Santos Artero,
7 it was recommended by his superior officer that Michael James Santos Artero
8 be Duty Instructor, noted that he was a superb administrator, managing over
9 twenty-five personnel, and a motivating team leader who developed three
10 watch teams consisting of thirty-three junior personnel, enabling the U.S.S.
11 Tarawa to complete every mission; and now therefore, be it

12 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina' Bente Ocho Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,
13 on behalf of the people of Guam, memorialize the contributions and
14 accomplishments of Michael James Santos Artero, affectionately known as
15 "Mikie", and express the heartfelt condolences of the people of Guam to his
16 family; and be it further

18 the people of Guam, recognize the family of the late Michael James Santos
