WHEREAS, Ms. Freida A. Jose began her career with the Guam Visitors Bureau as its Executive Secretary on September 1, 1982; and

WHEREAS, in her capacity as Executive Secretary, in addition to providing support to the General Manager, she was also responsible for preparing documents for, and taking minutes of, the Guam Visitors Bureau’s Board of Directors meetings; and

WHEREAS, in November of 1983 Ms. Jose was appointed to the position of Administrative Assistant and made responsible for the coordination of Guam Visitors Bureau’s membership activities; and

WHEREAS, almost four (4) years later, Ms. Jose was given the title of Special Projects/Membership Officer, and was designated as the lead staffer to be involved in those capital improvement projects approved by the Guam Visitors Bureau Board of Directors and funded through legislative appropriations from the Tourist Attraction Fund and other sources; and

WHEREAS, over the past eighteen (18) years Guam Visitors Bureau has been ably represented by Ms. Jose in various programs and projects including the \$52 million Tumon Bay Development Project, the annual Tumon and Hagatña Beach Cleaning and Maintenance contracts, the Tumon Landscaping and Maintenance contracts, the Island-wide Roadways Beautification and Maintenance project, the Holiday Illumination project, and the Island Village Beautification project, and

WHEREAS, Ms. Jose has been a fixture since 1983 in the organizing and conducting of the quarterly Guam Visitors Bureau’s Membership meetings and the biennial election of the industry’s four (4) members to the Guam Visitors Bureau’s Board of Directors, and
