2 required emergency action/fire extinguisher training for GUARNG personnel; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Klawitter additionally assisted the National Oceanographic and  
4 Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) in Guam in the implementation of their  
5 Environmental Compliance and Safety Assessment System (NECSAS), his duties also  
6 including organizing, scheduling, staffing, conducting and reporting on environmental,  
7 health and safety assessments throughout the United States and all of its territories; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the NECSAS assessments encompassed 46 different protocols, most  
9 specifically concerning health and safety, as well as applicable local regulations which  
10 vary among jurisdictions, and project completion was accelerated, using a state-of-the-  
11 art Assessment Manager computer program specifically developed for NECSAS, Mr.  
12 Klawitter typically producing a draft report concerning 10-15 facilities in a one-week  
13 time frame; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Klawitter also assisted in the development of NOAA's Web-  
15 Hosted Assessment Manager, an integrated, web-based compliance assessment tracking  
16 system incorporating NOAA business rules and quality control throughout the  
17 reporting process, while tracking findings to closure with the use of the internet; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Klawitter has 16 years of comprehensive environmental,  
19 occupational safety and health experience, including eight years within a corporate  
20 environment working with all organizational levels from operations staff through all  
21 levels of management, including managing large, complex, multi-disciplinary  
22 environmental, health and safety programs and projects worldwide, and has conducted  
23 and/or managed over 275 health and safety compliance assessments at manufacturing  
24 facilities worldwide, as well as at over 100 federal facilities in 15 states and territories and  
25 has conducted and/or managed over 50 environmental compliance assessments at  
26 federal and state facilities in 16 states and territories; and

27 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Klawitter, a frequent visitor to Guam, hails from Denver,  
28 Colorado where he makes his home with his wife of 11 years, Sharon S. Klawitter and  
29 their eight year old daughter, Shannon; now therefore be it
