BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'BENTE OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN*:

WHEREAS, Paul M. Shintaku was appointed by the Governor to assume the position of Deputy General Manager for Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port on January 13, 2003 and his appointment was confirmed by the Port Board of Directors in their September 4, 2003 meeting; and

WHEREAS, upon his employment with the Authority, his first mission was to reverse the Authority's financial trend after nine consecutive years of operating losses; and

WHEREAS, through his guidance, the Authority reported a net earnings of \$775,000 in 2003 despite Super typhoon Pongsonwa and the West Coast lockout; and

WHEREAS, through Paul Shintaku's leadership, the employees stepped up to the challenge of taking control of the Port's finances and operations and instituted budgetary constraints; and

1 WHEREAS, through his outstanding management skills, the Authority was
2 transformed from a dispirited and financially troubled agency to one that realized
3 profits for fiscal years of 2003, 2004 and 2005; and

4 WHEREAS, Paul Shintaku is resigning from his position as Deputy General
5 Manager of the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port to assume a more active
6 role as a senior Army Reserve Officer to the Marianas; and

7 WHEREAS, Paul Shintaku is not only a dedicated and hard-working
8 employee but an outstanding Deputy General Manager who motivated the Port
9 employees to strive for excellence;

10 WHEREAS, it is the hope of all that the loss of the employees of the Port
11 will be a gain for the people of Guam since Paul Shintaku will be devoting his time
12 as a reservist of the United States Armed Forces; now therefore be it

13 RESOLVED, that *I Mina’Bente Ocho Na Liheslaturan Guahan* does hereby,
14 on behalf of the people of Guam, commend and Paul M. Shintaku for his
15 outstanding service to the people of Guam and expresses sincere gratitude for his
16 contributions to the Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port; and be it further

17 RESOLVED, that the Speaker certify to, and the Secretary of the Legislature
18 attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted
19 to Paul M. Shintaku; and the Honorable Felix P. Camacho, *I Maga’lahen Guåhan*.
