10 Martinez now serves as the 105th Troop Commander, Guam Army National
11 Guard, and one of the very most distinguished members of the Guam

2 Martinez has provided outstanding contributions to the island of Guam,
3 through community service, the protection of the public and service oversees
4 fighting for our nation; and

6 recognized by the Armed Forces with numerous medals, awards and badges,
7 including: Meritorious Service Medal; Army Commendation Medal (1st
8 OLC); Air Force Commendation Medal; Army Achievement Medal; Army

10 (1st OLC); Global War On Terrorism Medal; Humanitarian Service Medal (1st
