Relative to showing the heartfelt appreciation of the people of Guam by welcoming Emmanuel D. Pacquiao, the Super Featherweight Boxing Champion from the Philippines, on behalf of the people of Guam, upon the occasion of his visit to our island.

- 1 WHEREAS, Emmanuel D. Pacquiao was born on December 17, 2 1978 in General Santos City, South Cotobato, Philippines; and 3 WHEREAS, Emmanuel D. Pacquiao moved from his hometown to Manila penniless and worked as a construction worker and sold 4 5 cigarettes in the streets while training and developing his passion for 6 boxing; and 7 WHEREAS, Emmanuel D. Pacquiao's early fights were usually in 8 small venues and televised in the Philippines during an evening boxing 9 show, Vintage Sports' 'Blow by blow'; and
- WHEREAS, Emmanuel D. Pacquiao, nicknamed 'Manny', is also known as 'Pacman' and 'The Destroyer'; and
- WHEREAS, Emmanuel D. Pacquiao started his professional boxing career in 1995 at the weight of 106 pounds and jumped in weight to 112

- 1 pounds to fight and win the World Boxing Council Flyweight Title in
- 2 December 1998. In a course of twelve months, he gained more weight to
- 3 122 pounds to fight and win the World Boxing Council International
- 4 Super Bantamweight Title. He defended this title five times before his
- 5 successful fight for the International Boxing Federation Super
- 6 Bantamweight Title in June 2001. By May 2004, he was fighting for both
- 7 the World Boxing Council International and the International Boxing
- 8 Federation's Featherweight Titles. He has since fought under the Super
- 9 Featherweight division weighing at 130 pounds from March 2005 to
- 10 present; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Emmanuel D. Pacquiao's current boxing record
- 12 shows the total number of fights of 47, with 42 wins, 33 wins by
- 13 knockout, 3 losses, 2 draws, and 0 no contest; and
- 14 **WHEREAS**, Emmanuel D. Pacquiao is now one of the most visible
- 15 and recognizable among the Filipino people and is considered a
- 16 household name because of his product endorsements, multitudes of
- 17 appearances in the media, a movie about his life 'Pacquiao: The Movie'
- 18 portrayed by famous Filipino actor Jericho Rosales, and several
- 19 Philippine movie appearances. He also produced and sang "Para Sa
- 20 'Yo", meaning "For You" in Tagalog, which became a hit single
- 21 throughout the Philippines; and

WHEREAS, Philippine President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo spoke 1 2 proudly of Emmanuel D. Pacquiao during her 6th State of the Nation 3 Address by pronouncing him as one of the Philippines' modern day heroes, saying, "Mabuhay ka, Manny"; and 4 5 WHEREAS, Emmanuel D. Pacquiao arrived on Guam on the evening of Saturday, August 26, 2006 and has since met with and 6 7 inspired many Guam residents with the story of how he overcame many 8 hardships throughout his lifetime; now therefore, be it RESOLVED, that I Mina'Bente Ocho Na Liheslaturan Guåhan does 9 hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, express our heartfelt 10 11 appreciation and welcoming Emmanuel D. Pacquiao, also known as 12 'Manny', 'The Destroyer', 'Pacman', and the Super Featherweight Boxing 13 Champion from the Philippines, upon the occasion of his visit to Guam; 14 and be it further 15 **RESOLVED** that the Speaker and the Secretary of *I Mina'bente Ocho* 16 Na Liheslaturan Guåhan attest to the adoption hereof and that copies of 17 the same be thereafter transmitted to Emmanuel D. Pacquiao; Her 18 Excellency Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo, President of the Republic of the 19 Philippines; to the Honorable Teresita Mendiola, Consul General of the 20 Republic of the Philippines; and to the Honorable Felix P. Camacho, I Maga'lahen Guåhan (Governor of Guam). 21
