3 WHEREAS, Mrs. Rosemin Sogo-An was born in South Cotabato,
4 Philippines on June 2, 1954 and has been married to Santiago Sogo-An, with
5 whom she has three (3) children, Shariffa, Sheryll and Randy, since 1978; and

6 WHEREAS, Mrs. Rosemin Sogo-An graduated from the Graduate Nurse
7 Program at the Saint Anthony School of Nursing in Roxas City, Philippines in
8 1975; and

9 WHEREAS, in 1979, Mrs. Rosemin Sogo-An received a Bachelor of Science
10 in Nursing from Central Philippine University in Iloilo City, Iloilo, Philippines;
11 and

12 WHEREAS, Mrs. Rosemin Sogo-An first arrived on Guam in 1981 where she
13 began working at Rexall Drugs as a sales clerk; and

1 **WHEREAS**, also in 1981, Mrs. Rosmin Sogo-An became a Respiratory
2 Therapy Technician with the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority, where she was
3 employed until 1984; and

4 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Rosemin Sogo-An obtained her Licensed Practical Nurse
5 (LPN) licensure in 1984 and gained employment with the Department of Mental
6 Health and Substance Abuse (“DMHSA”); and

7 **WHEREAS**, her first assignment with DMHSA was in the medication clinic,
8 where she had the opportunity to learn how to conduct Mental Status
9 Examinations and also administer medications to consumers in their homes; and

10 **WHEREAS**, in 1993, she passed the Commission Graduate Foreign Nursing
11 School Examination, a requirement to take the National Council Licensure
12 Examination (NCLEX), and subsequently passed the NCLEX in 1994; and

13 **WHEREAS**, while employed with DMHSA, Mrs. Rosemin Sogo-An also
14 held the positions of Aftercare Nurse as well as Acting Supervisor and Acting
15 Administrator for the Nursing Services Division. Mrs. Sogo-An was also named
16 Employee of the Year in April 1990; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Rosemin Sogo-An has served the government of Guam, in
18 the area of healthcare, for a total of twenty-nine (29) years and ten (10) months,
19 thus demonstrating her commitment to the health and well-being of the people of
20 Guam; now, therefore, be it

21 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina’ Bente Ocho na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on
22 behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and commend Mrs. Rosemin Sogo-An for
23 her contributions to Guam and its people in the area of healthcare and further
