1 BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'BENTE OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN  
2 GUÅHAN:

3 WHEREAS, Frank Blas Aguon, Jr., a son of Guam, was born on June 21,  
4 1966, one of six children born to Francisco Blas Aguon, Sr. and Marcelino  
5 Cepeda *van* Guerrero Aguon; and

6 WHEREAS, Frank Blas Aguon, Jr. is the devoted husband of Jennifer  
7 Uncango Lujan Aguon, the loving father of *Jennavie,* Frank III, Brittany and  
8 Christopher and the proud grandfather of Keeailah and Nathan; and

1           **WHEREAS**, Frank graduated from Father Duenas Memorial High  
2 School in 1984 and then obtained a B.S. in Business Administration and a  
3 Master's Degree in Business Administration from the University of Denver in  
4 Denver, Colorado in 1988 and 1990, respectively; and

5           **WHEREAS**, Frank Blas Aguon, Jr. has served the people of Guam as  
6 Director of Commerce, an Ex-Officio member of the Guam Finance  
7 Commission, as Chairman of the Guam Territorial Planning Commission, and  
8 as an analyst for the 19<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup>, 22<sup>nd</sup> Guam Legislatures; and

9           **WHEREAS**, Frank Blas Aguon, Jr. has also served Guam in many  
10 positions in private organizations such as the Associate Member of the Guam  
11 Chamber of Commerce, Vice President of the Habitat for Humanity, Finance  
12 Officer and Treasurer of the Guam Amateur Baseball League, the Fundraising  
13 Chair of the Guam Red Cross and others too numerous to mention; and

14           **WHEREAS**, Frank Blas Aguon, Jr. has had the honor of being elected  
15 Senator by the people of Guam five times and served the island faithfully as  
16 such in the 24<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup>, 26<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> Guam Legislatures, sitting on numerous  
17 committees; and

18           **WHEREAS**, throughout his ten years as Senator, Frank Blas Aguon, Jr.  
19 has vigorously championed the rights of the people of Guam, stood up for the  
20 common man, and has forcefully advocated for fiscal accountability,  
21 improved government services, the rights of government workers, the  
22 integrity of the Government of Guam Employees' Retirement Fund and has  
23 sought an improved relationship between Guam and the federal government;

1           **WHEREAS**, Senator Aguon's fellow Senators found him to be a  
2 congenial and conscientious Senator, always willing to discuss as well as to  
3 lend an ear, but a fierce and eloquent opponent when fighting for the people  
4 of Guam; and

5           **WHEREAS**, Frank Blas Aguon, Jr. will not be returning to the Twenty-  
6 Ninth Guam Legislature, but the people of Guam have high expectations for  
7 his future; and

8           **WHEREAS**, it is fitting to honor and thank Senator Aguon upon the  
9 occasion of his leaving the Guam Legislature; now, therefore, be it

10          **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina' Bente Ocho Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,  
11 on behalf of the people of Guam, commend and congratulate Senator Frank  
12 Blas Aguon, Jr. for his service in the Guam Legislature; and be it further

13          **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Secretary of the  
14 Legislature attest to, the adoption hereof and that copies of the same be  
15 thereafter transmitted to Senator Frank Blas Aguon, Jr.; to Mark Forbes,  
16 Speaker of *I Mina' Bente Ocho Na Liheslaturan Guahan*; and to the Honorable  
17 Felix P. Camacho, *I Maga'lahen Guåhan*.
