RELATIVE TO COMMENDING THE REPUBLIC (TAIWAN) ON ITS **CONTRIBUTIONS** TO PROMOTE WORLD HEALTH, AND SUPPORTING THE REPUBLIC OF CHINA'S (TAIWAN'S) ENTRY INTO THE WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I 1 2

MINA'BENTE OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, the preamble of the World Health Organization ("WHO") 3

Constitution recognizes that "the enjoyment of the highest attainable standard 4

of health in one of the fundamental rights of every human being without

distinction of race, religion, political belief, economic or social condition"; and

WHEREAS, the Republic of China (Taiwan) and its twenty-three million

five hundred thousand (23,500,000) people wish to join the World Health

Organization as an observer; and

WHEREAS, because health and disease have no borders, it is in the best 10

interest of the advancing of human condition that the Republic of China

(Taiwan) be afforded membership in the WHO in order to benefit, like all

other members, from information in the prevention, monitoring and cure of

epidemic diseases, prevention of terrorist bio-chemical attacks, and

discussions of global health policies; and

WHEREAS, the Republic of China's (Taiwan's) achievements in the field of health are substantial, which includes having one of the highest life expectancy levels in Asia; maternal and infant mortality rates comparable to those of western countries; the eradication of such infectious diseases as cholera, smallpox and the plague; and the first to eradicate polio and provide children with Hepatitis B vaccinations; and

WHEREAS, the Republic of China (Taiwan) has expressed a willingness and possesses the ability to financially and technically assist international health activities supported by the WHO; and

WHEREAS, in light of all the benefits that Taiwan's participation in the WHO can bring to the state of health not only in Taiwan, but also regionally and globally, Taiwan and its twenty-three million five hundred thousand (23,500,000) people should have appropriate and meaningful participation in the WHO; and

WHEREAS, the WHO Preamble further states that "the health of all peoples is fundamental to the attainment of peace and security and is dependent upon the fullest cooperation of individuals and States", and therefore, direct, unobstructed participation in international health forums and programs is critical to limit the spread of various infectious diseases and achieve world health; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Executive Committee of *I Mina'Bente Ocho Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam commend the efforts of the Republic of China (Taiwan) in their contributions supporting

world health, and further supports observer status for the Republic of China 1 2 (Taiwan) at the World Health Organization's assembly; and be it further
