



Relative to designating May 2005 as Guam Nurses Month and recognizing the contributions of individuals in the nursing profession to the people of Guam.

1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF I
2 *MINA' BENTE OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:*

3 WHEREAS, the Guam Board of Nurse Examiners has issued
4 approximately six-hundred sixty (660) registered nurse licenses and one-
5 hundred thirty-two (132) licensed practical nurse licenses, thus making
6 those in the nursing profession the largest group of healthcare providers on
7 Guam; and

8 WHEREAS, those individuals in the nursing profession on Guam are
9 essential to providing quality healthcare services to island residents; and

10 WHEREAS, the scope and extensiveness of the nursing profession
11 meets the diverse and increasing healthcare needs of the island of Guam;

13 WHEREAS, nationally, the American Nurses Association, of which
14 the Guam Nurses Association is a constituent member, has designated May
15 6-12, 2005 as "National Nurses Week" in celebration of those in the nursing
