9 Pelican Award in recognition of outstanding service to the spiritual  
10 development of Catholic Youth in the program of the Boy Scouts of America-  
11 Guam; and

13 Public Service Award in recognition for his participation and support of the  
14 Spirit of America celebration event from then Governor Paul M. Calvo.
