WHEREAS, some unknowing pet owners have allowed their animals to run loose and unsupervised, in violation of local law, thereby causing a threat to public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, the indiscriminate breeding allowed by these unknowing pet owners who have not had their animals spayed and neutered has contributed greatly to Guam's pet overpopulation, as has the activity of the unknown number of homeless animals; and

WHEREAS, Guam Animals In Need shelter volunteers and employees, like police officers and emergency medical personnel, must often respond to community problems and crises involving homeless animals; and

WHEREAS, the Guam Animals In Need Animal Shelter serves as a safe haven for Guam's homeless and abused animals, providing them with comfort and care; and

WHEREAS, Guam Animals In Need helps both animals and people in many ways by returning lost pets to their owners, recommending enforcement of animal control laws, rescuing injured animals, educating the public, and matching up families with new animal companions; and

WHEREAS, the work of Guam Animals In Need volunteers and the important services they provide often goes unnoticed and unappreciated by the citizens of Guam and deserves recognition; now, therefore, be it
